**NEW BUSINESS: a).** Diane Masura shared an STOCC (Save The Occidental Community Center) report. In general, their efforts have really boosted utilization of the building, they have added a weekly event – Occidental Community Market that runs through the first of June and all tolled, the building utilization is up over 841% for Q1 2010 compared to Q1 2009.
