Farmers Market: Starts June 5th with COVID19 modifications. I passed on our two checks to Katy Mamen who was coordinating the business sponsorships. The price tag went up to \$2K for the higher level sponsorship. **No public restrooms available- per the website.**

Fire Safe Orgs: FSCM is moving forward with our CWPP virtually through a series of surveys, educational videos, and live virtual community meetings. Working on coordinating with the

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County Chipper program to publicize and maximize local use and address the hard to get to residences.

FSO wants to send info to the parcel owners, which took quite a bit of clean up from the info provided by the county. There are 1200 parcels. Postcard will direct them to the FSO website to complete the survey.

Also working on a virtual community meeting- for mid June.

Schools: Matthew is doing a great job but not getting much help from public health with info on opening in September. Staff has been brainstorming about how to use the campus.

Health Center: Nothing new to report. Still only seeing a limited number of patients. Trying to slowly open some hours in Occ. A lot of people like doing the telephonic.
