Candi Penn updated the group on the Occidental Emergency Preparedness project – she has connected with Jane Berry at the West County Health Center and is moving forward and investigating resources available – her next outreach is to the Occidental Volunteer Fire Department – more info to follow at upcoming meetings.

**SCHOOLS:** 1). The Garden to Table (Wellness Program) has been successfully launched and kids are enjoying healthy, locally sourced lunches; 2). The "Mosaic Project" lead by Laurie Prothro has been an incredible project and will become a model for an annual student project on the school grounds; 3).
